Pictures from our school Maths Fact Day which we shared with our partner schools. 9th June 2017

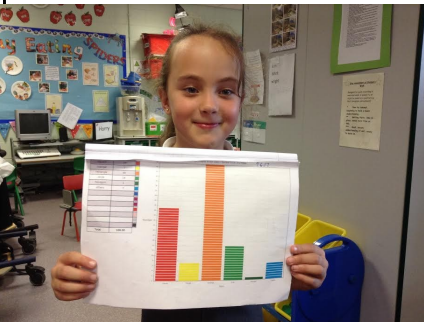
Reception

As part of our schools maths fact day, we have measured the plants in our outdoor area. This has helped us to understand measurement in a concrete way.



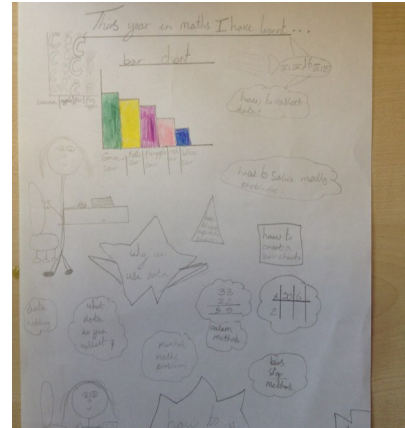
Year 1

We created a bar chart of our favourite fruits. Some of the children were able to transfer this information onto the laptop. Learning a new skill.



Nursery

We have been learning to count to 10 in Spanish. We are really good at counting to 10 in English, so Miss Jones has been helping us to count in Spanish.



Year 3

We made posters about the things we have learned in Maths. This has allowed us to reflect and consolidate prior learning.
