

## Year 3

During the first half of the Autumn term in theme we will be learning about The Stone Age to Iron Age. In Science we will be looking at Animals (including humans). The ideas below are just suggestions. Feel free to be creative and add some of your own.

In Science we are learning about different types of animals, including humans. If you have a pet write instructions to help someone to care for your animal if you're not there (food, exercise needs etc). If you don't have a pet find out what different animals in the zoo might eat and write a meal plan for the day.



Read regularly or have stories read to you. Particularly, stories with familiar settings e.g. stories set in a school or at the beach.

Use a piece of computer software to create a fact file about a living thing found in the local environment.

We are looking at Faith stories in RE. Read a story from a major faith and try to learn it. Re-tell the story in your own words. Illustrate it in comic book style.

Begin to learn all of the times tables up to  $12 \times 12$ . Keep practising number bonds to 10, 20, 50, 100

Write a book review about the stories you have read. What did you like about the story? Who was your favourite character? Would you have ended the story differently? If so, how?

Draw or paint an Autumn picture. You could collect leaves and conkers, acorns etc to make a collage.

Visit the World Museum to look at the Stone and Iron Age artefacts. Write a report including pictures about what you saw. Alternatively use the internet to research tools and weapons used in these times.
