Maths— Learn your 3,4,6,7,8,9 times tables . Can you learn the division facts too? For example... 4x3=12 3x4=12 12÷4=3 12÷3=4

<u>Fractions</u> – can you write some fractions problems? Watch the videos on Espresso Education. <u>Measurement</u> — can you make a cake measuring in grams and kg, measure items around your home in cm and metres etc.

<u>Class Novel</u> — Bad Dad by David Walliams. Write a character profile or draw a poster advertising the book.

Science— We are finding out about Electricity. Make a safety poster about

English— We are writing stories with historical settings. Can you visit the local library and find some children's fiction books that have a historical theme? For example The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas, Goodnight Mr Tom, The Railway Children.
