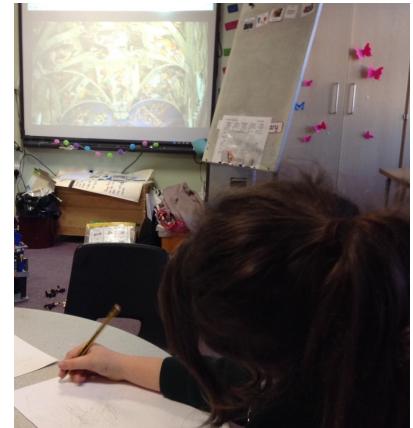


Reception
