During the second half of the Autumn term in Theme we will be studying Geography and looking at 'Our local area'. In science we will be looking at the changing of the seasons from Autumn to Winter. The homework ideas below are just suggestions, please feel free to add your own.

Count how many houses are on your road.
Write down the number of houses you can see.

Learn about the four different seasons and write a couple of sentences talking about how each season is different.

Draw a picture of your house and garden .
Draw the people who live in your house next to it and write their names underneath their picture.

Learn some songs and rhymes with numbers in, e.g.
ten fat sausages, five little speckled frogs, five little monkeys jumping on the bed.

Practise reading and writing number bonds to 10.
You can do this at any time even in the car or on the way up to bed!

Read regularly or have stories read to you.
Particularly stories with familiar settings.
For example stories set in a town or in a school

Learn about your local area. What is in your local area? Think of all the things that you would like to have in your dream local area—how about a train or a roller-coaster ride?

If you have a computer at home you can practise your word processing skills. Start by practising typing your name and a simple sentence about yourself. Can you make the font bigger/smaller? Can you change its colour?
