own.

Read some recipes and cookery books and read the instructions looking for bossy verbs. Cook something that you haven't made before.

> Read regularly or have stories read to you. Particularly, non-fiction information books and different books by the same author. Do you have a favourite author?

Learn about a famous King or Queen from history. What did they do that made them famous in history? Make a fact file or poster about them. Learn your numbers bonds to 10 then 20 off by heart. Practise writing them in a pattern like this:

10 + 0 = 10

Make a shoebox version of your garden or design your own shoebox garden.

Practise counting in 2s 5s and 10s to over 100, forwards and backwards. You don't even need to start from 0, you can start from 30 for example.

Draw your family tree. Ask your parents and grandparents about your family. Do you have any family living in different parts of the country or even the world?

Make a crown for a King or Queen and decorate it.
