Below are some ideas of activities that you can do at home as well as the Oak Academy work. Enjoy and let us know how you get on please. We can't wait to see you all on Wednesday 7th October.

Share a book with your family (especially novels by significant authors like Michael Morpurgo and Roald Dahl). This could be you reading to adults, adults reading to you or a mixture of the two.

In class we are reading 'Sky Chasers' by Emma Carroll.

You could write a short review, a character description of Magpie or Pierre a diary entry. You could draw some illustrations from the book.

Science: Try making your own solar oven. Feel how the temperature changes according to the direction it faces (into the sun or away from it) and how cloud affects the heat inside. Put a photo on Twitter to show us how it turned out.

Do some bird watching! Keep a tally of the birds you see in your garden or yard. Sketch the birds you see and try to name them.

Spanish: Practise counting in Spanish and draw a colourful rainbow and label the colours.

Geography :

Write a weather report for Liverpool and Iquitos City, Peru. Make comparisons between tropical and non-tropical areas

Art: Practise creating graffiti art . Make it

big, bold and **bright!**

Try to stay active and get some exercise. You could use the Joe Wicks workouts or go onto the GoNoodle website if you can. Be creative at home. How many times can you go up and down the stairs in 2 minutes? How many laps of your yard or garden can you do? I believe that you can use tins of beans as weights!! Give it a go!

Practise the times tables up to the 12 X table. Remember to practise them in order and also out of order as well as the division facts that go with them. Try to learn any little tricks to help you (like the 9s on fingers).
