


Year 3

During the first half of the Autumn term in theme we have been learning about the Stone Age and how people lived during that time. In Science we are looking at rocks and fossils. In Art we are looking for signs of Autumn. The ideas below are just suggestions. Feel free to be creative and add some of your own.



Read regularly or have stories read to you. Can you find information in books at home or from the library about the Stone Age or rocks? You could collect information and make your own book.

We are looking at Faith stories in RE. Read a story from a major faith and try to learn it. Re-tell the story in your own words. Illustrate it in comic book style.

Write a book review about the stories you have read. What did you like about the story? Who was your favourite character? Would you have ended the story differently? If so, how?

In Science we are learning about rocks including Igneous, metamorphic and Sedimentary rocks. You could look in your garden or near your house for rocks and stones. Can you decide what kind of rock they are?

Research a type of dinosaur and find out about where it's fossil was found.

Tell someone at home about Mary Anning and why she is famous.

Use a computer or an I-Pad to research the Stone Age and find some interesting facts.

Find some signs of autumn in your local area. Can you find leaves of different colours and make a leaf collage. Draw pictures to represent Autumn and label them.

Work on your times tables including the 2,5,10,and 3 times tables. Get a grown up to test you (maybe you could test them too!) We have been looking at place value and what numbers are made up of. You could show a grown up how to draw a number using hundreds, tens and ones.

Research stone age cave drawings on the computer or at the library. Can you make your own cave drawings.
