

## Year 5 (Monday 28th September - Tuesday 6th October)

Below are some ideas of activities that you can do at home.as well as the Oak Academy work. Enjoy and let us know how you get on please. We can't wait to see you all on Wednesday 7th October.

Share a book with your family (especially novels by significant authors like Michael Morpurgo and Roald Dahl). This could be you reading to adults, adults reading to you or a mixture of the two.

In class we are reading 'The Trouble With Perfect' by Helena Duggan.
You could write a short review, a character description of Violet or Boy or a diary entry.
You could draw some illustrations from the book.

Science: Design and make your own musical instrument using anything you have at home. Draw a picture of what it will look like and how it will work. How can you make it louder? How can you change its pitch? Put a photo on Twitter to show us how it turned out.

Do some bird watching! Keep a tally of the birds you see in your garden or yard. Sketch the birds you see and try to name them.

Spanish: Draw a body and use a search engine to label the parts in Spanish. Can you remember how to sing 'Heads, shoulders...' in Spanish? Demonstrate to a family mem-

History: Research the life of Elizabeth the First. Find out where she comes in a timeline of British Kings and Queens.

Art: Collect some leaves etc or ask someone to bring you some if you don't have a garden. Make a picture of autumn.

Try to stay active and get some exercise. You could use the Joe Wicks workouts or go onto the GoNoodle website if you can. Be creative at home. How many times can you go up and down the stairs in 2 minutes? How many laps of your yard or garden can you do? I believe that you can use tins of beans as weights!! Give it a go!

Keep practising the times tables you are unsure of. Remember to practise them in order and also out of order as well as the division facts that go with them. Try to learn any little tricks to help you (like the 9s on fingers).
