

Making sentences

Instructions for parents/carers

Read these words through with your child. Then get them to say the words. Make sure they can recognise them. Together use the words to make up sentences verbally.

Make short sentences using the words below. These could be things like –
I like blue flowers.

I like big yellow flowers.

I can see red and purple flowers.

Use the lined sheets of paper for them to write on or, if they have a computer at home, they can type them.

Make sure each sentence has a capital letter and a full stop.

Then ask your child to draw a picture to match what they has written about – i.e. I like blue flowers – a picture of a blue flower etc.
