Share a book with your family. Espresso has videos and information you can also use. Write about 'Why we Remember..' Write a 'Thank You' letter to a soldier thanking them for their service and sacrifice. Try writing an acrostic poem with the word REMEMBER. We wrote a formal letter— try writing one to Joe Biden (Vice President) with your hopes for America.
