

## Remote Learning via PlayStation 4 or Xbox One

There isn't an app, so you have to use the built-in internet browser instead.

**On Xbox**, it is Microsoft Edge, which is the standard browser that comes bundled with Windows.

**On PlayStation**, it is the "www" browser. Some children will know how to access each one, but if not, each games console has a search function they can access on the home screen. You use the controller to navigate in the same way you would use a mouse/trackball.

Once the browser has been opened:

1. Type in <https://app.seesaw.me> in the URL bar.
2. The see saw homepage will appear.
3. Select: I am a student.
4. Three options appear. The one you want to use is the box that says, "TEXT CODE". Your text code is supplied on the print out given to you in school.
5. Click Go
6. This will log you into see saw the same as it would on a computer or tablet.

If your child has a keyboard they can plug in, they will have a much easier time of navigation. Otherwise, they will have to use their controllers to click on the classroom tiles, open up assignments and type. It is not as easy with a controller, but children are far better at using them than adults, so they may find it is not that much of an issue.
