Measles

We have had no cases of Measles in school recently however there have been some outbreaks of Measles in other areas around the UK. Please remain vigilant if your child shows symptoms. Measles usually starts with cold-like symptoms, followed by a rash a few days later. Some people may also get small spots in their mouth. The rash starts on the face and behind the ears before spreading to the rest of the body. It's very unlikely to be measles if you've had both doses of the MMR vaccine or you've had measles before. Children should stay off school for at least 4 days from when the rash first appears.
