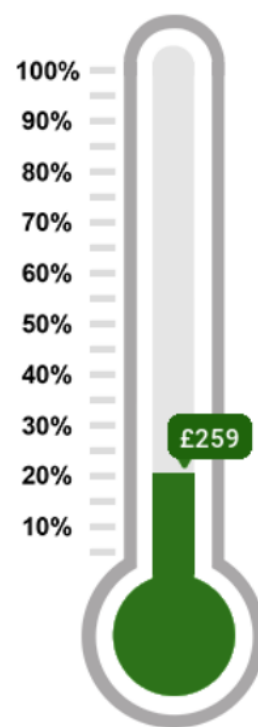

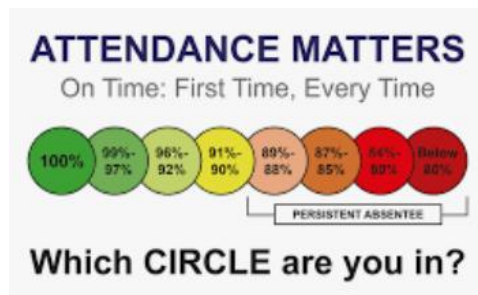
Y1 Trip to All Souls Church
